

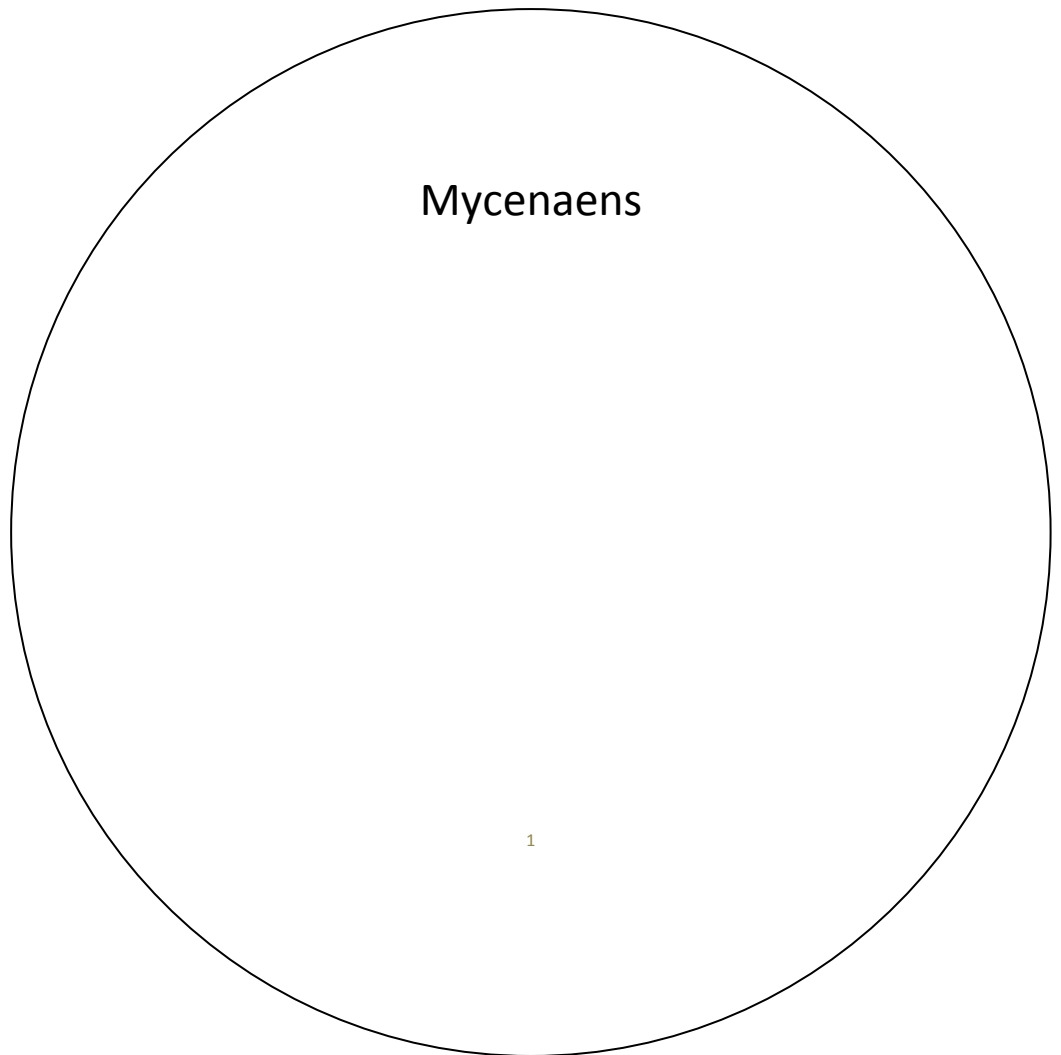
Cut out the three circles. Fold each one in half, writing on the inside. Glue the back of the left half of the first circle to the front of the left half of the third circle. Take the second circle. Glue the back of the left half of the second circle to the back of the right half of the first circle. Lastly, glue the front right half of the third circle, to the back right side of the second circle. Trim your edges to even them up if needed. Fold the entire thing in half. The back half gets glued to the lapbook, the front half is your title side. Open it and you have one full circle, turn the page and you have one more full circle. Use these two circles to compare and contrast the barbarians and the Mycenaeans.

- Couldn't read or write
- Spent time fighting other people
