Spartan boys went away to camp to learn how to fight.

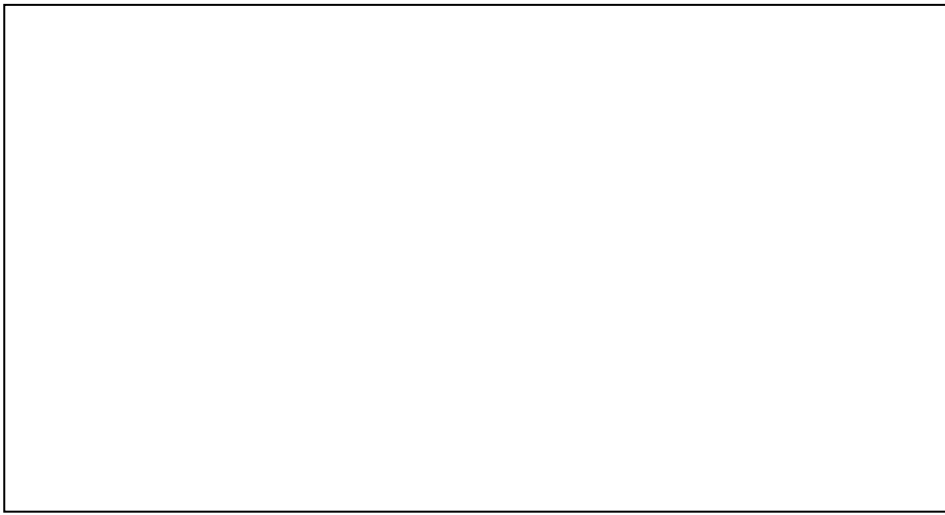
Men were supposed to be tough, brave, strong and silent.
